**A RESOLUTION OF THE CARROLL TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS,
YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR THE
PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS AND TRANSIENT RETAIL MERCHANTS
LICENSING FEE AUTHORIZED BY CARROLL TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE
NUMBER 2007-181**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance Number 2007-181 requiring the Peddlers, Solicitors and Transient Retail Merchants to register and be licensed; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance Number 2007-181, as fee, shall be established for that service; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code, Act of May 1, 1933 (P.L. 103, No. 69) Reenacted and amended November 9, 1995 (P.L. 350, No. 60) as amended, Section 1532(a), the Board of Supervisors may license and regulate by ordinance the business activities within the township; and


WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code, Act of May 1, 1933 (P.L. 103, No. 69) Reenacted and amended November 9, 1995 (P.L. 350, No. 60) as amended, Section 1532 (B), the Board of Supervisors may establish license fees for regulated businesses enumerated in subsection(a); and

WHEREAS, these fees shall bear a reasonable relationship to the cost of administering the ordinance and regulating, inspecting and supervising each business; and


WHEREAS, Licenses may be issued on an annual or monthly basis; and

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved that the fess shall not exceed three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per year or twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each month or part of a month.
