## **PennDOT to Reconstruct Route 74 Intersection near Dillsburg**

*Intersection of York Road, Campground Road and Spring Lane to be widened*

**Harrisburg** – PennDOT announced today that on March 9 construction crews will resume work on a project to widen and reconstruct the Route 74, York Road, intersection with Campground Road and Spring Lane in Carroll Township, York County. Last fall crews installed twin concrete culverts under the roadway just south of the intersection.

The \$1,408,345 contract was awarded to Kinsley Construction, Inc., of York, York County, and includes drainage installation, inlet work, roadway realignment, reconstruction, widening, grading, bituminous paving, installation of a new traffic signal, new signs and pavement markings. Work under this construction contract is scheduled to be completed by the end of September.

PennDOT advises travelers that they will encounter a slight traffic shift with a 10-foot lane restriction in each direction on York Road during roadway widening and reconstruction activities. Spring Lane Road will remain closed until the township bridge work is completed.

Travelers are advised to be alert for these operations, to obey work zone signs, and to slow down when approaching and traveling through work zones, not only for their safety, but for the safety of the road crews.

This section of York Road averages 10,660 vehicles traveled daily. To avoid delays, travelers should allow for additional time in their plans or seek an alternate route.


