Scott Vance – Stonebridge Drive – is here tonight to talk about Lots 98 and 99 which are to be proposed driveways to the two property owners behind the Stonebridge Crossing Subdivision. He is questioning why these driveways are not installed. They are part of the approved and recorded plan. He also questioned why these two lots are not part of dedication of the streets? When are the streets in Phase 1 going to be dedicated to the Township? He had lived here for 13 years and they are still not dedicated. The streets are in very bad condition.

John Prawdzik – 109 Cobblestone Way – he has lived in this development for 12 years and he has the same comments as Mr. Vance and Mr. Woodward. Will the Engineer be looking at the sidewalks along W. Siddonsburg Road? They should be included in the dedication.

Joe Woodward – 101 Graystone Court – questioned if the Township is going to provide leaf pickup in the development this year?

Chairman Trostle stated that Phillip Brath, Township Engineer, and Brandon Slatt, Construction Inspector, has walked the site and they know how bad the roads, curbing and sidewalks are.

Supervisor Moyer-Schwille questioned who would pay to have the proposed driveways paved?

Phillip Brath, Township Engineer, stated that he has walked the site and a list has been made. There are a fair number of items to be fixed. The Plan does not show the proposed driveways. Only the location of the apron and sidewalks. We are holding a bond for these improvements.

Brandon Slatt stated that he has marked some areas but not all areas have been marked up. He also stated the sidewalk and the apron have been installed for Lots 98 and 99.

Duane Stone, Township Solicitor, stated to look at the MPC lots – does not mean that the driveways have to be put in. Look at this closer.

The Board asked that this matter be placed on September 08, 2020 Work Session for further discussion.
