ADDITIONAL ITEMS

Phillip Brath, Township Engineer, presented the Plans in Process Report for February 2024.

Brandon Slatt, Township Manager/Zoning Officer, presented the Zoning Report for February 2024. Mr. Slatt stated there is a Zoning Hearing Board Hearing scheduled for February 26, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. The property is located at the corner of Hartman Lane and Baltimore Street. It currently is a vacant lot, and the owner wants to build a duplex on the property.

Chairman Sailhamer stated there is a meeting scheduled with District 8 to discuss the improvements at the intersections of Ore Bank Road, Spring Lane Road, and U.S. Rt. 15. He also questioned that there are no sidewalks along Gettysburg Pike on the right-hand side from Ameri Lube (Costa Oil) down to PSL(Presbyterian Senior Living). Can we ask them to install the sidewalk along their properties? Installing the sidewalk in this area would give the residents at

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PSL(Presbyterian Senior Living) a safe way to walk to Aldi when they open.

Supervisor Loudenslager questioned if we can ask the Carroll Township's DAA representatives to come to our Work Sessions to give monthly or quarterly reports. She is also requesting a monthly report from Community Networking Resources (CNR). CNR is the company we are paying \$4,000.00 per month for grant work. She stated that she does not want to see plans labeled Preliminary/Final anymore. Would like to see a policy on the submittal of plans. She also would like to amend the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance to require 3D model of the property to show an elevation view.

Brandon Slatt stated that CNR is going to submit monthly bills and do a quarterly report on the activities.

Darrell Dethlefs stated that Mr. Pykosh and himself are writing a subdivision and land development plan review policy and procedure to be adopted by a Resolution. He is hoping to have it ready for the March Work Session.

ADJOURNMENT

It was moved by Supervisor Loudenslager, seconded by Supervisor Wall, and unanimously carried to adjourn the meeting at 7:26 p.m.
