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**TOWING
PROCEDURES
FOR ACCIDENTS**

Ken Doll, Jr., owner of Ken Dolls General Repairs and Towing, is questioning the Board if the Carroll Township Police Department has a towing procedure for when there are accidents in our areas in which towing companies get called out. If the Township doesn't have one, he would like the Board to put one in place that would include his business and be on a monthly rotation. He would like to have a piece of the pie. He stated that the York County Control Supervisor called Chief Wargo concerning the towing procedures.

Chief Wargo stated that he had sent a copy of an email to Mr. Doll several months ago that was sent to the Police Officers after the death of Mr. Coulson. In this email he stated that the Department towing procedure would be: 1. See if the owner/driver has a towing request. If they do, then have York County Control contact that towing service. 2. If they don't have a towing request, make contact with one of the local towing services, example Allen's Towing Service out of Monaghan Township, or Ken Doll's Towing Service out of Warrington Township. 3. We do not have a primary towing company, you can use whoever you feel is appropriate. Whoever is appropriate will have a quick response and will treat the public vehicles with care. 4. All impounded vehicles will be brought back to Carroll Township Police Department. 5. If you require a commercial motor vehicle to be towed 1st request should be Interstate Towing out of Lower Allen Township and if they are not available 2nd request should be Charlie's out of York. It would be up to the investigating Officer on site to call a towing company. The Officers were not told not to call Ken Doll Towing. Chief stated that there is no legal requirement for the Department to come up with a list for towing. Also, Chief Wargo stated that York County Control was requesting a list of towing companies and their information so when the Officers call County Control they would have the information in their computer instead of having to look it up. This is not a list of who you shall use. The list is C & C Towing, Allen's Towing Service, Ken Doll's Towing Service, and for larger commercial motor vehicles would be Interstate Towing and Charlie's.

Chris Piper, owner of C & C Towing, is happy with the current towing procedures and will work with any changes that the Board would like to do.

Supervisor Schmick stated that it is strictly 100% up to the investigating Officer on who is chosen.

Supervisor Rocco stated that York County Control has no control over the Carroll Township Police Department only the Board of Supervisors does. He also questioned Mr. Doll what is his township of residence.

Chairman Ritter stated then you are soliciting for business by building relationships with Police Departments and Fire Companies. Carroll Township does not have a set policy for towing and we do not tell the Police Department on how to set their Department Policy on towing.
