DISPOSE OF YOUR UNWANTED MEDICATIONS PROPERLY

Carroll Township Police Department has received a MedReturn box which will be located in the hallway between the Police Department and the Township side of the building. Please bring all of your old or unused medications to the box so that we may dispose of them for you. These items must be from residential York County sources. This keeps them out of the hands of children and ensures the water supply is not contaminated if they are flushed down the toilet.

The items that are accepted are: prescriptions, prescription solid or liquid medications, prescription patches, prescription ointments, inhalers, over the counter medication, vitamins, samples, and medications for pets.

Not accepted items are thermometers, hydrogen peroxide, aerosol cans, personal care products in the form of non-prescription ointments, liquids or lotions, medications from businesses or clinics, needles (sharps), bloody or infectious waste and hazardous waste.
